EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Toxic by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Moisture sensitive.

Potential Health Effects

Eye: May cause eye irritation.

Skin: May cause skin irritation. The toxicological properties of this material have not been fully investigated.
